

DWU PROGRAM

A post-secondary 2 year certification program for transition students with intellectual or developmental disabilities

- Provides a variety of courses for audit or credit
- Utilizes Person Centered Planning
- Develop peer networks through extracurricular activities
- Offer on/off campus work experiences
- Find work opportunities through Vocational Rehabilitation Services
- Progress Reports provided quarterly



Student Eligibility Requirements

- Ages 18-21
- Qualify for funding through IEP
- Primary goal of employment
- Ability to fund books and meal plan if desired
- Ability to fund courses (VR may be able to help with cost if requirements are met)
- Access to and from DWU campus (VR may be able to help if requirements are met)
- Proven ability to independently participate appropriately in a classroom or professional setting
- Completed LifeQuest application and recommendation from a current teacher

School Eligibility Requirements

- Program fee - \$50 a day for program participation and supports. Please call for further information regarding the fee for service.
- Project Skills Match with VR



Other Transitional Services

Students that meet requirements, may apply for residential services through the LifeQuest Community Support Program, in addition to the DWU program. Extra fees outside of DWU program would be negotiated based on need.

Some or all of these services could be included:

- Continued job development services
- Obtaining affordable housing
- Financial Management/Budgeting
- Shopping
- Menu planning/cooking
- Cleaning and laundry
- Receptions and leisure skills
- Student may be assigned a Case Manager
