To support LifeQuest, do the following:

- 1) Type [smile.amazon.com](http://smile.amazon.com) in the address bar of your web browser.
- 2) Log in using your amazon.com account. Everything else is the same, including Prime.
- 3) Amazon will ask you to pick your own charitable organization. Type LifeQuest Foundation in search box and press "Search"
- 4) If multiple entries are listed, press select next to Mitchell, SD.

### LifeQuest Foundation Now Accepting Online Donations!

The LifeQuest Foundation can now take online donations via the Foundation's new website, [www.lifequestfoundation.org](http://www.lifequestfoundation.org)! "Donors have been asking for this feature," said Brian Loken, the Foundation's Development Director. "It's a simple and safe way to support us. The setup is easy to use, and continues to allow donors to give a Memorial or Tribute Gift, along with how we can let the family know of your gift."

Simply click on the "Give Today" link on the website and fill out the necessary information. After submitting information about the gift, it will submit that information directly to the Foundation, and will automatically re-direct you to WePay, an online payment service provider who partners with a number of online suppliers, such as gofundme. You will then submit your payment information and your gift will be given directly to the Foundation.

"Our tests have shown that we can receive your gift anywhere from later that day to three business days," said Loken.
